The cost is \$46 per person which includes an educational film in The Rangos Giant Cinema, a Buhl Planetarium show, exhibit exploration, hands-on activities, pasta buffet dinner (\$7 voucher), an evening snack, and breakfast.

On the day of the science fair, your group leader will be given a registration packet with necessary materials. He or she can then distribute those materials to the group. Group leaders are responsible for the supervision and behavior of their groups.
