More than 1,000 students research a topic, present their results on a poster board and speak to judges who include the area's most distinguished scientists and engineers. Nearly 500 awards are presented and one-third of the students win an award. Students in grades 9-12 are eligible to compete at the Intel International Science & Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF).
